Behavior/Discipline Policy

Rules

Consequences

1. Warnings*
2. A detention slip will be sent home to be signed by the parent and returned to school the next day.

*Planners will be utilized for conduct warnings (indicated by checkmarks). Any checkmarks will require a parent signature. Three (3) checkmarks will result in a detention.

The first detention will result in a lunch detention. After (1) lunch detention, subsequent detentions will be after or before school detentions, and guidelines will be followed as stated in the student handbook. After the 4th detention, the teachers, parents, and principal will meet. (per semester)

Homework

The second day late a drop of 50% grade will be given. If an assignment is turned in the third day or later, he/she will receive 0%.
